Full-time and Extended time Postgraduate Programmes in:

- **Bachelor of City Planning (Honours)**
- **Bachelor of Landscape Architecture (Honours)**
- **Master of Urban Design**
- **Master of Landscape Architecture**

UCT's School of Architecture, Planning and Geomatics offers these postgraduate programmes, resulting in widely recognised and highly marketable professional qualifications after the completion of the Master's degree in the respective disciplines. Successful completion of the City Planning (Honours) programme at UCT gives automatic entry to, and is a pre-requisite for, the Master in City and Regional Planning programme, with the two programmes together being locally accredited by SACPLAN and internationally by the Royal Town Planning Institute. The Bachelor of Landscape Architecture (Honours) programme has a one-year duration, and provides entry to the one year Master of Landscape Architecture programme, both of which are accredited in South Africa by SACLAP. Students with an Honours degree in landscape architecture can also apply to undertake the Master of Urban Design at UCT. These programmes are also available on an extended basis; the Honours degree programme can be taken over a period of two years. The Master of Urban Design programme is one-year taught Masters course that can be taken over 1 full time year or an extended 2-year period.

Students are involved in intensive programmes which cover both the practical and theoretical aspects of Planning, Landscape Architecture and Urban Design. Qualified graduates of the Master's programmes have the prospect of moving into influential positions in government and the private sector, and consulting with communities, businesses and other professionals. There is a growing demand for skills relating to the development of urban areas, urban renewal, informal settlement upgrade, provision of public services and infrastructure, transportation, environmental management, regional and rural development, and landscape planning and design.

**Entrance requirements: Please note the programme specific closing dates for SA applicants:**

- With a good undergraduate degree in any discipline, you can apply to enter the Bachelor of City Planning (Honours). - For the Bachelor of Landscape Architecture (Honours) a first degree in Architectural or Landscape Architectural Studies is required, although an additional conversion programme may be undertaken if candidates come from a non-design background.  
**Closing Date: 31 January 2022**
- Applicants for the Master of Urban Design programme require a minimum Honours or Masters in architecture, landscape architecture or planning. Non-design, but related Honours applicants can also undertake a conversion programme.
