

**PART-TIME TECHNOLOGY TUTORS – 2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

The School of Architecture, Planning and Geomatics would like to invite members of the architectural and allied professions to apply for part-time tutor positions which will be available in the Bachelor of Architectural Studies (BAS) programme for the 2021 academic year. As a Technology Tutor, the successful applicant will give assistance to Technology course convenors in the conduct of Technology projects. Most contracts will involve 3 hours work per teaching week plus the examination and marking, and will follow the academic calendar, which runs from the 15 March to 9 July and for the second semester from 2 August to 23 November 2021 - this is inclusive of the examination sessions in June and November (an example of the undergraduate academic timetable layout is annexed below).

The posts are suited to architects/professionals who are either running their own practices or who are employed in architectural firms. Particular consideration will be given to applicants who have demonstrated interest to pursue post-graduate study / work or have research interest or capacity in the area of design making.

Remuneration will be negotiated dependent upon expertise.
